2. **SECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SQ026/31 JANUARY 2015 SIN/FRA/JFK**

Please kindly note that a 24-hour cooling period is required for cargo (including XPS cargo) on flight SQ 026/ 31 January 2015 SIN/FRA/JFK.

Only live animals, perishables, P.O mails and newspaper/magazines are exempted from this 24-hour cooling period requirement. However, all cargo must undergo security screening and X-ray before uplift.

Dangerous goods and BUP/BUC are not allowed on the flight.

3. UPLIFT OF LITHIUM BATTERIES ON SQ FLIGHTS FROM JANUARY 2015

Reference to our Freight Talk BDM6A.01.001 dated 02 January 2105 item 3, please be reminded that you have to complete the additional Lithium battery document correctly with all required information. Do not leave blank or indicate “as per air waybill or as per manifest” on the Shipper and Consignee column, this is not acceptable and our handling agent will reject the shipment.
